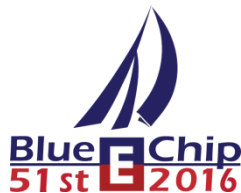


NOTICE OF RACE

1.) Eligibility and Entry

- 1.1 Eligibility is open to boats in the E Class that meet invitation criteria as selected by the regatta committee.
- 1.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached Entry Form, together with the required fee to:

2.) Fees

The \$175 entry fee includes registration materials, skipper and crew lunches. Additional lunches will be available for purchase for guests. There will also be a \$16 fee per person for the Thursday dinner and a \$45 fee per person for the Saturday dinner party.

3.) Schedule

- 1.3 Final Registration and Launching will be held at PYC regatta headquarters on Thursday, September 22, 2016 from 5 to 8 PM.
- 1.4 Competitors' Briefing will be held at the PYC clubhouse. Friday, September 23rd 9:00 a.m.
- 1.5 Race Schedule: Race days will be Friday, Saturday and Sunday. The first Warning Signal each race day shall be at 10am, unless changed per SI 3. No race shall start after Noon on Sunday.

4.) Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available to all competitors at registration.

5.) Scoring

- 1.1 The Low Point system as defined in Rule A4 will apply.
- 1.2 No scores will be excluded (this modifies Rule A2).
- 1.3 One completed race is required to constitute a series.

1.4 A boat that starts but does not finish will be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats that finished. This changes RRS A4.2.

6.) Venue

Regatta events will be held at the Pewaukee Yacht Club. Competition will be on the navigable waters of Pewaukee Lake.

7.) Radio Communication

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

8.) Prizes

The trophy presentation will be held on Sunday September 25th, at the Pewaukee Yacht Club after the last race. Trophies for the first 5 places in the final standings will be awarded. Six race trophies will be awarded. There is a traveling championship trophy as well. All participants will receive a commemorative gift.

9.) Disclaimer of Liability

The Pewaukee Yacht Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
