# **Scantling Vote Completed**

I want to thank all of the eligible Owner Members for your responses to the recent Scantling Rules amendment.

### previous:

- G. No boat shall be entitled to race as a bona-fide E-Scow unless:
- 1. The annual dues have been paid to the NCESA.
- 2. A current annual NCESA Active Owner Membership Sticker is affixed on the starboard side of the transom.

#### amended:

G. No yacht shall be entitled to race as a bona-fide E-Scow unless the current annual NCESA Active Owner Member dues have been paid to the NCESA. Dues shall correspond to a single yacht (club designator and racing number).

# WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

**The NCESA will no longer require an annual member sticker to be affixed to the transom**, however the NCESA by laws and scantlings still state that ALL BOATS MUST BELONG TO AN OWNER MEMBER TO

CONSTITUTE A SANCTIONED EVENT. A competing boat's membership status can be found using the member directory on the class website. Membership is critical to the continued success of our class!

Every boat must have a sole "Owner" member.

Any skipper must be at least a "Regular" member.

Co-owners in addition to the sole designated owner should become "Regular" or "Associate" members.

From By Laws:

- 1. An Active Owner member shall be a yacht owner, or a sole designated owner when in a boat partnership that has more than one owner.
- 2. Regular members shall be skippers, who are not Active Owners, and other people who want to support the NCESA.
