50th E Blue Chip Vision

To host a premier sailing event that celebrates the rich traditions of the E Scow, its Blue Chip and sailors by reuniting past mystery guests and honorary class legends with the top performing teams in 2015.

The <u>purpose</u> of this Communication is to answer a few basic questions about the 50th E Scow Blue Chip that will take place from Thursday, September 24 through Sunday, September 27, 2015.

The <u>focus</u> of this communication is aimed at E Scow sailors.

Questions this Communication will answer:

- 1. Who will be invited to sail in the 50th E Blue Chip?
- 2. How will the Skippers be matched to Boats & Crew?
- 3. How will E Scow sailors get to qualify for the event?

1. WHO WILL BE INVITED TO SAIL IN THE 50th E BLUE CHIP?

Two unique groups of Skippers will be matched with the Top E Scow Teams for this one-time Blue Chip event.

a. Skipper Invitations:

- 1. <u>Past Mystery Guests (PMG's)</u> the vision from the beginning of this idea has been to invite all living Mystery Guests back to Pewaukee to race against each other in the 50th Blue Chip.
- 2. <u>Honorary Class Legends (HCL's)</u> one addition to this core idea was to invite some of the class legends who have been champions and major contributors to the E class over the same period.

b. Boat & Crew Invitations: What the invitation is for and what it includes.

- 1. Qualifying E Scow Skippers will receive an invitation to the 50th with an assumption that they will bring the boat that they qualified in plus two crew members (jib man and a middle crew member). We will require that upon acceptance of the invitation, the skipper specify each crew member that they will bring along by name. This list may include a 4th crew member.
- 2. To be clear, the assumption is that the invitation is for the boat that qualified plus the crew. Part of the named crew can be the qualifying skipper. That is for the skipper/boat owner (if not the same person) to determine. The PYC will not participate in that team decision; simply require that this guideline is followed.
- 3. Agreement is that you will show up on Thursday, 9/24 midday, be ready to sail and you are committed to stay through the regattas completion on Sunday, 9/27.





2. HOW WILL THE SKIPPERS BE MATCHED TO THE BOAT & CREW?

Skippers (PMG and HCL) will be "paired" with the Qualifying Boats and Crew on Thursday, 9/24

a. <u>Lottery Style Selection Process</u> to be held on Thursday, 9/24 no sooner than 3:00 pm CDT. There are many reasons for taking this approach. One is fairness to level the playing field for ALL skippers (PMG and HCL). All skippers will be "paired" with their crew & boat at the same time. There will be no preselection. We will communicate more details of how we will do this at a later time.

b. Honorary Class Legends (HCL) Boat and Crew

1. Honorary Class Legends who are active in the fleet will have the option to bring their boat and crew, but have no guarantee they will be paired with them. It will be the HCL's choice to specify whether they will bring their boat & crew as part of their acceptance of the invitation.

3. HOW WILL E SCOW SAILORS GET TO QUALIFY FOR THE EVENT?

E Scow sailors will qualify for the 50th E Blue Chip through their racing results in various scheduled regattas during 2015.

a. The following is a list of 2015 qualifying regattas:

b. Further Qualification Detail:

- 1. A regatta needs to be at least 2 days and complete a minimum of 3 races to count.
- 2. The 50th Invitation Team reserves the right to go deeper into a fleet and make additional invitations based on both fleet size and fleet quality and not limited to these listed regattas.
 - a. For example, if a given regatta has only a 1st place winner designated in the table above and the regatta ends up with 25 high quality boats, the Invitation Team can choose to expand the number of invitations beyond the top finisher.
- 3. This communication does not provide an all-inclusive definitive qualification set of criteria.





- 4. The Invitation Team has intentionally kept the bar high and will likely go deeper based on 'actual' fleet depth as the season progresses.
